Last week we had a series of storms that caused damage to much of the Knoxville area. The Market was hit with minimal damage. Several roof panels were damaged and the freshly planted landscape was ripped out. Now, the roof was a million-dollar eco/energy efficient roof and the panels have to be ordered and installed by the manufacturer. These minor things need to be fixed before the City of Farragut will issue a Certificate of Occupancy. Technically, the market could open with the minimal damage, but the City of Farragut is holding up the works with the repairs.

I was waiting on confirmation of a new opening date when I heard that it was published in the newspaper over the weekend. August 12 is the date published.
